Scout Participant Qualifications:

- Scouts and team members MUST have a current BSA membership with a Boy Scout troop.
- Must be at least a First Class Scout before July 2017.
- Must be at least 12 years of age by the first day of the Jamboree or an 11 year old that has graduated the 6<sup>th</sup> grade, but has not reached their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday by the last day of the Jamboree.
- Be approved by the unit leader and local council.
- MUST have appropriate parent/guardian to complete the online parental consent. (An email will be sent to the parent/guardian during the application process.)
- Participate in pre-jamboree training experience with local council and unit leader.
- Filed a BSA Health & Medical Record with their council within one year of attending the Jamboree. (The local council will provide specifics closer to the Jamboree.).
- Submit all registration fees per the local council's payment schedule.

Venturing Participant Qualifications:

- Crew members MUST have a current BSA membership with a Venturing crew.
- Be approved by the unit leader and local council
- MUST have appropriate parent/guardian to complete the online parental consent. (An email will be sent to the parent/guardian during the application process.)
- Participate in pre-jamboree training experience with local council and unit leader.
- Filed a BSA Health & Medical Record with their council within one year of attending the Jamboree. (The local council will provide specifics closer to the Jamboree.).
- Submit all registration fees per the local council's payment schedule.

I have read and understand the Mandatory Terms for Participants, Code of Conduct and Terms and Conditions Waiver.

Payment Schedule is as follows:

\$100 Registration Fee Due with this form and gets you a spot in the Jamboree Contingent.

\$500 First Payment Due before 12/31/15.

\$500 Second Payment Due before 6/30/16.

\$600 Third and Final Payment due before 12/31/16.

I understand that I must make all payments on time and according to the payment schedule above. I understand late payments will carry a \$20 late payment charge. If payments are not made according to the schedule, I understand that I may be dropped from the active roster and moved to the wait list until payments are made current. Once your payments are current, you will be reassigned to the first available slot.

If you should decide to drop from the Council contingent, a paid replacement must be found before any refunds can be granted, and the \$100 Registration Fee is nonrefundable. If you drop out within two months of the Jamboree departure date, no refund will be granted until after the Jamboree to ensure that we have payment for a full contingent. If we do not have a full contingent, no refunds will be granted.

I understand that while submission of this form and payment of the required fee will temporarily reserve a slot in the Council contingent, registration is not complete until the National on-line registration process found at <http://www.summitbsa.org/events/jamboree/jamboree-registration/> is completed.
